- ✓ Please see Holidays for information on Trash and Recycle collections.
- ✓ Fee for Trash and Recycle collection is billed quarterly by J&J Refuse, as shown below:

Curbside - \$38.19 per quarter	Senior Curbside - \$34.77 per quarter
Condo per unit - \$38.19 per quarter	Senior Condo per unit - \$34.77 per quarter

(Senior rate is applicable if resident is 65+ years of age or handicapped.)

WEEKLY SOLID WASTE COLLECTION

- \$ COLLECTION DAY IS THURSDAY.
- \$ Solid waste amount shall be unlimited, one household per account.
- \$ Solid waste collection begins at 7:00 a.m. Please have trash at curb prior to that time to ensure collection. J&J cannot be responsible for non-collection due to late curbside placement.
- Solid waste should be put out in 32-gallon containers with lift handles weighing no more than 50 pounds. You may also use standard 30-gallon trash bags, if placed curbside on the morning of collection.
- To avoid damage by nocturnal animals, plastic bags containing food debris must not be put out until the morning of collection, prior to 7:00 a.m.
- \$ 55-gallon drums, barrels, or cardboard boxes are not acceptable containers and may not be used.
- \$ Bulk materials (brush, shrub trimmings, fencing, carpeting, etc.) shall be cut into 48" lengths and tied in 18" bundles weighing not more than 50 pounds. Construction debris will not be picked up in the normal collection. Call to arrange for a dumpster at extra charge for construction debris.
- \$ Leaves, grass clippings, or decomposable yard waste material may be put in bags or other suitable containers and placed at the point of collection for pick-up.
- \$ Furniture and appliances will be picked up on the regular collection day when placed next to trash.
- \$ DOORS MUST BE REMOVED FROM REFRIGERATORS AND FREEZERS.

WEEKLY RECYCLING COLLECTION

- J&J will provide yellow recycle bins to each home during the week of May 23, 2005.
- \$ Recyclables will be collected in a separate truck and taken to our recycling center. This collection will be on the same day as your regular Thursday trash collection, beginning at 7:00 a.m.
- \$ Co-mingled recyclable materials must be placed out in 18-gallon recycle bins. If you have more recyclables than will fit in your bin, use a clear or blue plastic bag and place the bag on top or beside the bin. (*J&J Refuse is not responsible for missed recyclables set out in regular trash containers, due to the difficulty in recognizing them as recyclables and not as regular trash.)
- \$ The following items for recycle are to be placed out in the 18-gallon recycle bins or blue or clear plastic bags:

All #1 PETE plastic bottles	Aluminum cans
All #2 HDPE plastic bottles	Bi-metal cans
NO other recycle-coded plastic containers will be accepted	Steel food cans
Clear, green, and brown glass – Jars & Bottles ONLY	Aerosol cans
- \$ Items to be tied with poly twine or string or placed in brown paper grocery bags:

Newspaper	Magazines – Glossy & Bound	Telephone Books	Corrugated Cardboard

- \$ We do not accept plastic food tubs, margarine tubs, yogurt containers, frozen food trays, plastic bags, egg cartons, paper food boxes, antifreeze or motor oil containers. Please include these items in your regular trash.

HOLIDAYS

- \$ If a Holiday falls on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday your trash collection will be delayed until Friday.
- \$ When the actual Holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, even if it is celebrated nationally on Friday or Monday, the trash collection schedule will not be affected by the Saturday or Sunday Holiday. J&J will collect trash, as normal, on Thursday.

OHIO EPA LAW

- Items such as paint, gasoline, oil, lead acid batteries and tires can only be disposed of at the HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE RECYCLING CENTER, located at 1201 Graham Road in Stow, next to the former Carter Lumber. Take State Route 8 south to Graham Road and turn left (head east across bridge) then turn left again (north) into the Recycling Center. Hours are: Tuesdays 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesdays 6:30 p.m. to 10 p.m. The Recycling Center is open from mid-April through the end of October, and is closed from the end of October until mid-April.
