

***Tree Trimming of Northfield Center Township Road right of ways  
during the month of November 2018***

---

Roads must be maintained in a safe operating order for the safety of vehicular and pedestrian traffic including the sides and overhead are free of obstructions. Fourteen feet of overhead clearance and up to right of way (25 feet from center of road)

Where? This involves all side roads in Northfield Center Township. This does not include County or State roads (RT. 82, Brandywine, Highland, Olde Eight, Twinsburg, Valley, and Walters roads)

Trees and shrubs will be properly pruned to insure minimal short-term harm to the plants and reduce long term problems from pest and disease caused by vehicular traffic damage to branches. Accidents and damage to vehicles from low and or over extended branches will be prevented.

Keeping aesthetics and the health of trees in mind there might be circumstances where a limb may need trimmed beyond the right of way which would be consulted with the homeowner before any action is taken.
