

Hunger Knows No Season... Hunger Takes No Vacation...

With so much going on, it is easy to forget that there are people in our community that are food insecure. That means that they do not know where their next meal is coming from.

The Emergency Assistance Center saw a 90% increase in clients served from 2012 to 2013. In just the first five months of 2014, the Center has already served 3,640 individuals.

THE NEED IS GREAT.

On May 11th the National Letter Carriers Food Drive took place all across the nation. The Emergency Assistance Center received a little over 6,000 pounds (3 tons) of food, due to our generous neighbors. That food sustained our pantry for only two and a half WEEKS! Our volunteers who spent days checking expiration dates and stocking the shelves were in utter disbelief as they watched the food donations quickly disappear.

School-aged children are now home for the summer. Meals that students had received free at school, such as breakfast, lunch and even a snack, now have to be supplied by parents that are already financially strapped.

LACK OF SUMMER DONATIONS.

With schools out of session, The Emergency Assistance Center does not have access to food drives that are hosted by the district throughout the year. Churches have tried to help, but often have low attendance due to congregants taking vacations.
